Nehemiah and Churches

Recently, I was meeting with a church's pastor search committee for the purpose of giving them guidance in their process. They shared how God had led them to study the book of Nehemiah as they sought God's plan for their church.

The next morning I awoke much earlier than usual and tried to go back to sleep. Not being very successful, I finally decided that maybe God had something to tell me, so I rose to go read the Bible. I chose to read the book of Nehemiah. What God showed me began to get me very excited!

Nehemiah had a burden from God to help rebuild the walls of Jerusalem. He went there for a set period of time and worked with

the people and the leadership to advise them and encourage them in the building of the walls. Nehemiah went and assessed the damage, and then with the authority given him by God and the people, he oversaw the rebuilding process.

As many of you know, I have had a burden from the Lord to help in the rebuilding of our Lord's Church. I left the pastorate over four years ago to go to churches for the purpose of helping them get back to a God-centered focus, and away from a man-centered focus. I have been able to preach in many churches across this country as I have sought to help churches to refo-
